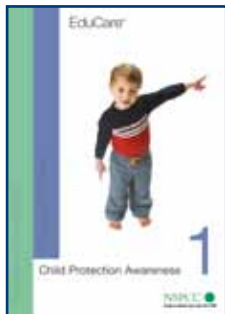

NSPCC Child Protection Awareness

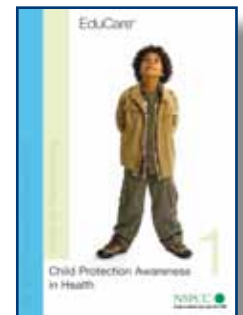

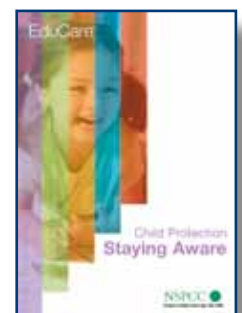
NSPCC Child Protection Awareness in Sport and Active Leisure

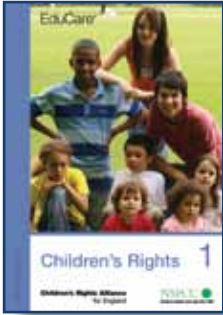

NSPCC Child Protection – Staying Aware Test

The NSPCC recommends that everyone who comes into regular contact with children and young people should update and refresh their child protection knowledge every three years. Child Protection – Staying Aware is designed for people who have previously completed Level 1 or 2 child protection training. It consists of a questionnaire that will test a participant's child protection knowledge and also their understanding of how to promote the welfare of children and young people.

NSPCC and Children's Rights Alliance for England Children's Rights

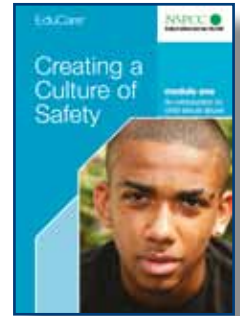

NSPCC Preventing Bullying Behaviour

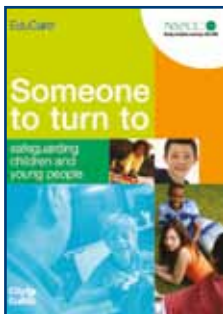
