Are you

- Living in the Liverpool City Region (Halton, Knowsley, Liverpool, Sefton, St Helens or Wirral)
- Aged 19+
- Working, recently unemployed within the last 12 months or looking for work e.g. coming back into the workforce
- Needing digital skills to take up a new role, or to significantly increase your responsibilities in your existing role

#### What you'll get

- A fully funded training programme
- Support and assessment
- Digital skills training for jobs
- An opportunity to receive careers guidance and gain a job interview
- Flexible training arranged around you, to allow you to take part if you are currently in work, looking for work or have caring or other responsibilities
- A training programme lasting up to 12 weeks which includes digital skills, employability and other skill needs
